Local organizations 'Adopt a School'

The members of the local Wilberforce Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., and the PALS (Promoters of Art, Literature, and Science) and their women's auxiliaries have embarked upon a dramatic "Adopt a School" project with McKinley Elementary School, Xenia, Ohio.
